Please be advised that there will be a meeting of the Faculty Organization on June 30th at 2:00 p.m. in M-19. At this meeting we will determine procedures for selecting an Interim President.

At the last Faculty Organization meeting the following criteria for candidates for the position of Interim President were discussed and voted upon:

- 1. The person will come from inside Medgar Evers College.
Vote: Inside 16 Outside 14 Either 13
Because a majority was not reached, a second vote was taken.
Vote: Inside 22 Outside 21
- 2. The person will have tenure at the College.
Vote: Yes 32 No 0 Abstain 1
- 3. The person should have a background of community involvement in the inner city.
Vote: Yes 31 No 0 Abstain 1
- 4. The person should have a history of positive involvement in the struggle for quality education.
Vote: Yes 27 No 0 Abstain 1
- 5. The person shall be a female. It was moved that this criterion be stricken.
Vote: Yes 25 No 11 Abstain 0
It was then moved that the criterion read: The person should be sensitive to the needs of a predominately female institution and that women be encouraged to apply.
Vote: Yes 29 No 1 Abstain 0
- 6. The person should have a background as an effective administrator.
Vote: Yes 29 No 1 Abstain 0
- 7. The person should have demonstrated support for the students' demands and issues.
Vote: Yes 29 No 1 Abstain 0
- 8. The Interim President will not be a candidate for permanent president.
Vote: Yes 28 No 4 Abstain 1

It is obvious that because of the closeness of the vote on criterion #1, further discussion of this crucial issue is needed. Likewise, decisions made at this meeting will have a lasting effect on the future of the College.
