TRENT MUST RESIGN  
IN WRITING

1. The Court decision only stopped the police force from serving the injunction.
2. The Board of Trustees can still use police action without the court's approval.
3. The Board of Trustees is using 'time' to cover-up Trent's and their lack of leadership and ability to resolve a university crisis.
4. The struggle continues. The Students, Faculty, and Community demand Trent's resignation or removal immediately.
5. The Students, Faculty and Community have to send letters, call and make the members of the Board of Trustees aware of the crisis at our college.
6. The Students, Faculty and Community have to send letters, call and remind our black elected officials that the struggle is not over at Medgar Evers College.
7. The Students, Faculty and Community have to send letters, call and even visit Dr. Trent to remind him that he should resign.
8. The Students, Faculty, Alumni and Community must continue to unite and work to remove Dr. Trent.
9. With unity and collective action, the Students, Faculty, Alumni, Community and elected black officials will remove Dr. Trent.
